CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This event will be conducted under the EFA Dressage Rules, effective January 2008 and FEI rules where the former do not apply, subject to any amendments or inclusions. The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to alter, change or delete any competition from the program.
2. This event is open to financial EFA and QISEA members.
3. Age of Riders of Horses exceeding 149cm with shoes or 148cm without shoes must be aged 12 years to the end of the year in which they turn 21 years
Age of Riders of Ponies NOT exceeding 149cm with shoes or 148cm without shoes must be aged 10 years to the end of the year in which they turn 21 years
4. Each horse entered must have the **same** rider as nominated in the entry form for **all** competitions at this event.
5. Horses may compete in two consecutive levels only e.g. Preliminary/Novice, Novice/Elementary etc.
6. Horses must have a current performance card.
7. Horses competing at FEI levels must be at least 7 years of age and have at least 80 EFA grading points and have on two occasions achieved 60% in Advanced judged by at least two judges.
8. Only correct and fully completed entry forms will be accepted. Any omissions or mistakes will result in the entry being returned. Phone entries or late entries will not be accepted.
9. **Scratchings and Refund of Entry Fees** – Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of the completion of the event. In such cases, 50% of the entry fee will be retained by the OC. Entry fees will be refunded in full for scratchings before the closing date (30/4/08). The administration fee will not be refunded.
10. No substitution of horses will be permitted after the close of entries.
11. The draw will be strictly adhered to.
12. All competitions will be restricted to 30 entries. However, the OC will consider allowing a maximum of 35 entries in some competitions depending on entries and time constraints. Entries will be based on qualifications. Should the number of nominations per competition exceed 30, balloting will occur using the performances submitted with entries (see condition 15). If horses are balloted out they will be placed in order on a reserve list and will be offered a place if and when a scratching occurs. If a rider does not wish to remain on the reserve list, they must scratch from the event or entry fees will not be refunded if a place in the competition is offered but not taken up.
13. The qualification period for this event is from **18 months** prior to closing date **1/11/06 to 30/4/08**.
14. **You must be the regular rider of the horse as per condition 4.**
15. **For each level**, Two (must) or three (preferred and used for balloting) performances of the horse/rider combination at the level you intend to compete are to be submitted. Ranking order – EFA Official, EFA Associate, QISEA, PCAQ. Proof of these performances must accompany the entry form (i.e. photocopy of the dressage test sheets, copy of performance card, copy of results from Salute Magazine or official State Magazine, or a copy of the results sheet). If balloting occurs, horses with proof of 3 performances will be included before those horses which have only 2, 1 or no performances at that level. (e.g. 2 x 65% divided by 3 = 43%, 2 x 65% and 1 x 50% divided by 3 = 60% average).
16. All ponies must have a height certificate. Any pony that doesn't have a height certificate for this event must be prepared to have their pony measured on the day of competition if challenged or the pony appears to be over the regulation pony height of 148cm without shoes or 149cms with shoes.
17. Awards and Placings – As per the rule book – Section 3.18 & 3.19.
18. Objections and Appeals: Objections must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$100. Attention is drawn to Rule 4.2 of EFA Dressage Rules (2008).
19. Hors Concours (HC) entries will **not** be accepted.
20. Callers are **not** permitted at this event.
21. **Whip** – A whip, not exceeding 1.2m in its entirety (including the tassel), may be carried in competitions up to and including Advanced. The carrying of a whip in the FEI competitions is not allowed.
22. The Organising Committee reserves the right to accept or reject entries.
23. **Late entries will not be accepted.**

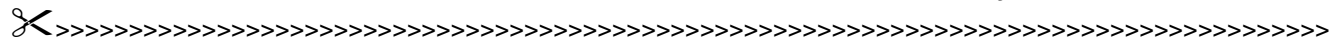
GENERAL INFORMATION

DOGS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR THE DRESSAGE GROUNDS AT ANY TIME. THIS IS A REQUIREMENT OF THE DPI. IF YOU BRING A DOG TO THE EVENT YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS IMMEDIATELY

1. This event is a restricted EFA event; therefore EFA grading points will not be awarded.
2. Riders must be ready to ride at nominated time. No changes will be made to draw times, other than in exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the OC. A revised draw may be posted the day before each competition to allow for scratchings/withdrawals. The starting order will not alter and a move up system will apply. The onus is on the competitor to confirm/check their starting times the day before the competition.
3. Bridle Numbers **must** be worn on both sides of the horse and be clearly visible to the judges. Riders are requested not to speak to the Judges prior to entering the arena. All horses that are registered with the EFA have been allocated permanent bridle numbers. This number will be used by your horse at all official dressage competitions in Queensland including Young Rider Championships. Your bridle number must be included on the entry form. **Please ensure that the bridle number on your nomination form is the bridle number you will use at the event. If you do not have a bridle number it will be necessary to purchase one at the time of entry.**
4. Please note that random swabbing may be carried out at this event.
5. Overnight camping and stabling is available at the Show Grounds. Stabling and camping must be booked and paid for on the entry form.
6. **Freestyle:** Only the movements up to and included in the current tests at the level being ridden may be shown. Music must be supplied on a good quality CD with any relevant instructions (including name of horses/rider and rider's starting signal) attached. It is the responsibility of all competitors in the Freestyles to provide the CD set at the correct starting place and to ensure that the music is recorded at the correct speed and sound level. CDs must be handed to the Event Director on Friday 13th April by 3pm. All Freestyle competitions will be held in the indoor arena at the Caboolture Showgrounds commencing on the Saturday afternoon 14/6/08. It is strongly recommended that you have a backup CD of your music.
7. Please complete and supply with your entry a short resume of yourself and your horse for the commentator if you are competing in Freestyle Classes or CDI-Y competitions
8. **Weather:** If, after the event has commenced, it is necessary to cancel competitions due to inclement weather the OC will only refund 70% of the entry fee to those competitors entered in those cancelled competitions.

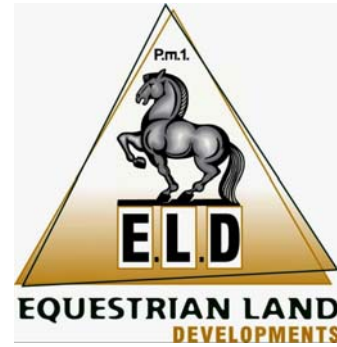

General Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Riders may participate under the jurisdiction of the country of which the rider holds their passport • Riders should be aware that the FEI considers any withdrawals without a valid excuse after the definite entry date as serious • Riders may ride two horses in the Freestyle
Horse Inspection/ Trot-Up	All horses entered in the CDI-Y are subject to a Fitness Inspection. This inspection will take place on Thursday 12 June 2008 at 4pm. All CDI-Y horses must have a current FEI Passport or Official FEI recognised EFA Identification Document. Please note: EFA ID documents must be registered and validated/numbered by the EFA National Office. Riders/owners requiring an EFA ID document should contact the EFA National Office.
FEI Registration Fee	All riders and horses participating in CDI-Y's during 2008 must be registered on the FEI database . <u>Registrations must be renewed each calendar year</u> . The EFA collects the charges on behalf of the FEI. Registration forms are available on the EFA web site. www.equestrian.org.au or contact the National Office. Please note that this registration is required even if the horse has an FEI Passport or EFA National Identification Document.
Advertising/Publicity	Advertising and Publicity on competitors and horses (Gen Regs Art. 136.1-2). The competitors are authorised to carry the logo of their personal sponsor on the saddle cloth. A sponsor's label on jackets must not exceed 80 sq cm at the height of breast pockets. The Chief Steward will check that the advertising and publicity on competitors and horses complies with Article 136 of the General Regulations.
Whips	It is, under penalty of elimination, forbidden to carry a whip of any kind while competing in the arena. However, the use of one whip, with a total maximum length of 110 cm in the practice area is allowed. The whip must be dropped before entering the space around the competition arena or the rider will entail a penalty of 4 points (= 1% in Freestyle tests) per judge. Upon arrival on the showground, only the rider when riding, walking, leading or lunging a horse (lunge whip allowed) is allowed to carry a whip (maximum 110 cm) anywhere on the showgrounds. The groom may also walk, lead and lunge the horse as above. Other parties are allowed to carry a whip, provided it is not in connection with the training of the horse.
Draw	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the Individual competition there will be an ordinary draw. • For the Freestyle competition the draw will be in reverse order of the Individual results in groups of 5.
Prize Money	Will be distributed in accordance with FEI Rules Article 451
Objections/Appeals	Refer to General Regulations Art. 167 & 170. They must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit of 150 SFR (approx. \$150 AUD).
Closing Date	Competitors please note the following closing dates: Definite entries: 30/4/08. Unless we receive written notification from competitors beforehand, we will assume entries are confirmed as definite by the 30/4/08 .
