CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

THIS EVENT WILL BE CONDUCTED IN STRICT ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT EDITION (INCLUDING AMENDMENTS OF THE

EA Dressage Rules Effective 1st January 2011 plus amendments.

- **Competitors** are advised to be aware of the Rules. Please refer to Section 8 of the 2011 EA dressage rule book for rules relating to the conduct of national/state Championships. The onus is on riders to know the rules under which they compete.

MEMBERSHIP & HORSE REGISTRATION

- **Horses**, Ponies, owners and riders must be financial with EA or, if from overseas, with their National Federation. Horses must compete under their full registered name. All horses competing must be registered. The OC has the right to abbreviate a horse's name for printing purposes. Membership numbers must be shown on the Entry Form.

ENTRIES & ELIGIBILITY

Age: Current Dressage rules apply e.g. from the start of the calendar year they turn 12 years of age when riding horses, 10 years of age for ponies. In the event that you are riding in competition 14 FEI YR Grand Prix (16 – 25 years) you will be eligible to ride in competition 13 and competition 29. Competition 14. The test for this class will be the Young riders Grand Prix test (16 -25 Years). We will use this test for all ages wishing to do this competition.

- **Horses/ponies:** May compete in two (2) consecutive levels only. For example Nov/Elem, Adv/PSG etc. They may compete in a maximum of three (3) tests including a freestyle per day. Horses must exceed 149cm with shoes, 148cm without shoes. Ponies must not exceed 149cm with shoes or 148cm without shoes.. Each horse entered must have the same rider as nominated on the entry form for all competitions. Any change of rider must be notified to the OC Secretary before the commencement of the event.
- **Competitions: (EA levels)** are open to horses and ponies that are graded Preliminary, Novice, Elementary, Medium, Advanced and have less than 30 upgrading points, or FEI., at close of entries.. FEI competitors must comply with the pre requisites to compete at this level as per rule 1.14.
- **Official Grading:** This will be taken as at the date of close of entries.
- **Draw:** Competitions will be limited to 35 depending on entries and time constraints. If balloting occurs a reserve list will be kept. The OC reserves the right to rank horses if necessary. A revised draw may be necessary the day before each competition to allow for withdrawals. The onus is on the competitor to confirm/check their start times the day before the competition.
- **Performance eligibility:** The qualifying period is the 12 months preceding the closing date of entries e.g. 26/5/10 to 25/5/11 (see point below for balloting information and number of official performances to be submitted). All entries for EA and FEI level tests must be qualified by having 3 performances at the level they are entering during the 12 month period preceding the closing date. Only 1 Official HC score may be used as a qualifying score. In case of balloting performance qualifying scores will be considered from official, associate and IQ competitions in that order. If you are nominating for classes 13 and 14 small tour and big tour performances will be considered. **No qualifiers are necessary for any Para Equestrian tests.**
- **Ranking (Balloting):** Will be based on the average of the highest percentages of three tests at the particular level, in the 12 months before the close of entries (see above.) Riders who submit 3 performances (only one of which may be Official HC) will be considered ahead of those who submit one or two performances. **No qualifiers are necessary for any Para Equestrian tests.**
- **Pony:** Preliminary/Novice/Elementary/Medium & Advanced Championship awards will only be presented if there are at least 5 competing at the relevant level at the close of entries at the OC discretion. Ponies are required to nominate for their competition level. All ponies will follow at the end of their nominated level.
- **Para Equestrian:** Championship awards will only be presented if there are at least 3 or more in a class at the close of entries.

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- **Objections and appeals:** Objections must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$150.00. Attention is drawn to Rule 1.3 & 1.4 of EA Dressage Rules.

WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

- **Scratchings and Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of the completion of the event. In such cases, 50% of the entry fees can be retained by the OC. Entry fees will be refunded in full for scratchings before the closing date, and, for riders on the reserve list who are not offered a start in a competition. The administration fee will not be refunded.
- **Withdrawals:** (rule 8.4): No competitor shall withdraw from a competition within 8 hours before the start of the competition without the permission of the OC. A written statement giving reasons for the withdrawal must be handed to the Event Secretary prior to the commencement of the competition. Penalty for non compliance – maximum of \$200.
- **Because:** of reserve lists all riders faced with a likely withdrawal are asked to consider their fellow competitors and notify the OC as soon as possible.

SADDLERY AND EQUIPMENT

- **National/State Competitions:** A whip not exceeding 1.2m in its entirety may be carried up to and including Advanced level.
- FEI competitions – A whip is NOT allowed

FREESTYLES

- **Only** the movements up to and included in the current tests at the level being ridden may be shown.
- **Music** must be supplied on a good quality non scratched CD with any relevant instructions attached in writing. Please clearly mark rider/horse and bridle number on the CD. **It is** recommended that you have a back up of the master CD with you.
- **CD** must be handed to the event director/secretary prior to the competition on Saturday morning.
- **Please** complete and send with your entry form a short resume of yourself and your horse for the commentator if you are competing in Freestyle classes (form attached).
- **A separate** cheque for the freestyle bond of \$50 is to accompany the nomination form, this will be shredded (if not collected) after the freestyle has been ridden, or a veterinary or medical certificate supplied 24 hours before hand.

EVENT RESTRICTIONS

- **This event** is a restricted EA event, therefore grading points will not be awarded. **Riders** must be ready to ride at nominated time.
- **No** changes will be made to draw times. **The** starting order will not alter and a move up system will apply.

CALLERS - are not permitted at this event.

FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

The Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI'S code of conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery, tack and transportation.
- Horses and competitors must be fit competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medications use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Class presentations will be advertised on the day. Champions at each level will be presented at the conclusion of the competitions on the day. All riders are expected to attend the presentations in full competition dress including boots and hat. This is compulsory - failure to attend in correct attire will result in forfeit of awards. Presentation will be unmounted.

BRIDLE NUMBERS

Two bridle numbers must be worn at all times when out of the stable and in competition must be clearly visible to the judges. Riders are not required to stop or talk to the judges prior to entering the arena. Please ensure that the bridle number on your entry form is the bridle number you use at the event.

WEATHER

If, after the event has commenced, it is necessary to cancel competitions due to inclement weather, the OC will refund 50% of the competition entry fee/s only to those competitors entered in cancelled competitions. The administration fee will not be refunded.

STABLING

Must be booked and paid for with entries. There will be a large number of stables available at the Caboolture show grounds and will not be allocated but available on a first in first served basis.

CAMPING

Must be booked and paid for with entries. Onsite powered camping is available throughout the Caboolture show grounds, and will not be allocated but available on a first in first served basis.

CATERING

A range of catering will be available at the competition.

Entries and Team Event Requirements

Nominated team members must compete in the nominated classes over the event. A team of 3 riders must be nominated by 8am on first day of competition. You may nominate for more than 1 team but no horse can be used in more than one team.

The winning team will be the team with the highest total score, the second is the one with the next highest score and so on. This means the percentages (scores) will be added together to determine the team scores.
